Founded in 2014, Noora Health turns hospital hallways and waiting rooms into classrooms by tapping into the most compassionate resources available for the patient's care: their own family.

With the support of six state governments in India, the Government of Bangladesh, and large private hospital systems, Noora Health has trained more than two million caregivers across 329 facilities. In a cohort of patients, the program reduced post-surgical cardiac complications by 71%, maternal complications by 12%, newborn complications by 16%, and newborn readmissions by 56%.

We seek an experienced mobile developer to create tools to improve internal processes and support building patient and healthcare provider-facing digital products that advance our mission.

WHAT YOU WILL DO

- Use your strong coding skills for real social impact and play a key role in setting up the technology vision of the organization
- Support the entire lifecycle of mobile app development (concept, design, test, release, and post-release support)
- Build pixel-perfect, buttery smooth UIs usable across mobile platforms and device sizes
- Build lean and easy to use apps that ensure the best performance and experience for the user
- Ability to work with backend developers and UI/UX designers to deliver well-architected products
- Liaise with the product team to plan and develop new features for future products and releases
- Write clean, maintainable, and scalable code that is production-ready and well-tested
- Explore new technologies that can streamline internal processes and work
- Use basic analytics tools and techniques to understand user behavior and suggest changes to existing products (or enable other team members to do so)
- Maintain codebase of existing projects; Diagnose and fix bugs that may be reported from time to time; Write automated tests (using tools like Jest or Mocha) before all major releases

- Experience writing industry-grade, well-tested code for a mobile application
- Strong leadership skills and ability to collaborate with multiple stakeholders to see a product to completion
- Experience working with standard development tools like IDEs, command line tools etc.
- Ability to work with uncertainty and rapidly adapting to changes
- Experience deploying apps to Playstore and AppStore.
- Excellent communication skills
