WHO WE ARE

Noora Health's mission is to improve outcomes and strengthen health systems by equipping family caregivers with the skills they need to care for their loved ones. Founded in 2014, Noora Health turns hospital hallways and waiting rooms into classrooms by tapping into the most compassionate resources available for the patient's care: their own family.

With the support of six state governments in India, the Government of Bangladesh, and large private hospital systems, Noora Health has trained more than two million caregivers across 329 facilities. In a cohort of patients, the program reduced post-surgical cardiac complications by 71%, maternal complications by 12%, newborn complications by 16%, and newborn readmissions by 56%.

WHAT YOU WILL DO

Lead efforts to design, implement, and operate monitoring processes for end-to-end

monitoring of key programs

- Coordinate logistics for internal learning initiative which includes scheduling, documentation, organizing stationary, setting up zoom links, etc.
- Design and develop presentation desks, template design, ideas for interactivity
- Collaborate within internal teams to identify topics for capacity building throughout the organization
- Building out the schedule in consultation with the department leads

- Coordinate with external speakers and consultants to scope out topics and sessions
- Support in communication, implementation, and documentation of learning sessions (e.g. speaker series, deep-dive sessions)
- Ideate and implement attendance tracking, engagement processes, and participation recognition
- Collect feedback on sessions and suggest possible iterations on the larger learning experience for Noorans and external facilitators alike
